Opportunity definitions –

Adviser: this typically involves working with groups of students – sharing knowledge and expertise – as they work through a series of tasks and challenges

Judge: usually working as part of a panel, judges will review a wide range of student projects and activities against a score sheet or competition criteria

Interviewer: volunteers take on the role of an interviewer and meet/assess students against fictitious jobs, placements or University places
