These sessions helps members who have experienced, or who are at risk of homelessness to access courses, volunteering and employment giving Crisis members the valuable chance to hone their interview skills for a range of roles, from care through to call centre positions. They complete a formal panel interview with the volunteers and receive feedback and advice on their performance from the panel to help them to build their skills for the future. Crisis members find these sessions a real confidence boost as some are experiencing their first interview in several years.

Crisis wouldn't be able to change so many lives without the support and commitment of volunteers throughout the year across the UK.
