Context:	Civil Service Local is a cross-government programme, working closely with the Cabinet Office and engaging with our agencies and departments to influence the delivery of Civil Service Reform. We have a set of core themes to provide: • better opportunities for staff; • better services for the public; • better value for money. Civil Service Local works across government departments and is funded by HMRC, DWP, MoJ. HO and MoD.
Role Purpose	This role sits within the CS Local North East, Yorkshire and The Humber team and the Project Manager will be responsible for planning and delivering our connecting people strategy. This includes our activity on establishing a number of Cross-Government Networks, which are a way of connecting people from different government departments, with a view to improving the working environment and developing a more efficient and flexible use of the Civil Service estates, assets, shared services and expertise. We currently have seven active networks, but there is demand and scope for more. Objectives of the role include: To drive delivery of our connecting people strategy; To design and test new projects which support the agenda; To raise awareness of CS Local and its products. The successful candidate will be required to engage stakeholders and project teams from across the Civil Service and other public sector bodies plus interact with customers and stakeholders from a range of organisations across the region.

Role Specifics	Location: The role can be based in any North East, Yorkshire and The Humber location but will involve regular trips to Newcastle to access on-line documentation and liaise with the Civil Service Local team. Other travel will be involved but this will be mostly in the North East, Yorkshire and the Humber. *Loan: This would suit a full-time (in addition to other duties) or part-time worker at SEO/HEO, although other grades will be considered if potential in their behaviours and skills is clearly evident.
