We are looking for examples of individuals or groups who make outstanding personal contributions to our communities.

Nominations will be considered against award-specific criteria as well as the following elements:

Inspirational Person

Recognising individuals or groups who are role models and inspire others to get involved in local activities or projects to benefit North West communities. Through their perseverance, talent, generosity and commitment, they have enriched the lives of others.

Community Champion

Recognising the contributions that individuals or groups, through hard work and commitment, make to the lives of others resulting in a positive impact upon their community.

Courageous Person

Recognising individuals or groups who have put themselves in danger to help or save the life of another or have battled against the odds.

Outstanding Carer

Recognising individuals or groups who have given up their time to look after someone else. People who have gone the extra mile and made sacrifices to improve someone else's quality of life.

Outstanding Fundraiser

Recognising individuals or groups who have gone beyond all expectations to raise money for a good cause, however large or small the amount.

Contribution to Community Sport & Recreation

Recognising individuals or groups for their outstanding contributions to sport and recreation. People who volunteer their time, energy and expertise to sport and recreation in the North West.

Contribution to Conservation & Environment

Recognising individuals or groups who are helping to improve the environment and encourage sustainable development in the North West.

Who is organising the Pride of the Civil Service North West Awards?

Civil Service Local North West

How do I enter?

You can enter yourself or be nominated by a colleague. Approval for shortlisted nominations will be sought from a Grade 7 Civil Servant.

What if I am a Senior Civil Servant?

You must have your nomination signed off by someone of a more senior grade within the Civil Service.

Who can enter the Civil Service Awards?

Any civil servant who is currently employed.

When will the shortlist be announced?

To be confirmed within good time of the awards ceremony.

What happens with my nomination?

The Pride of the Civil Service North West Awards judges will review the nominations and select the winners in each of the awards categories.

The winners will be announced at a prestigious reception in September 2016 to celebrate their achievements.

Do I have to tell the person I am nominating them?

We advise that you let anyone you are nominating know that you have done so at your own discretion. It is not compulsory to do so but it is usually best to inform them in advance so they are not caught off-guard if they are shortlisted. It's also an opportunity to let them know what fantastic work they have done!
