	The theme would be a cruise ship which would call in at a different port/country every day. We can dress up the hall to emulate a cruise ship (complete with captains table!) and theme the days e.g. Spain/Paella/Flamenco dancersthe world is our oyster!
	This could be done over several days with our shared resources, Age UK volunteers, and cadets (ages 13 -18) providing support.
