Organisation Name and purpose	Oak Tree House is a supported housing project in Lancaster for homeless people over 25. It comprises 23 units of accommodation over two floors which include six crisis units, 12 move-on en suite bedrooms and five self-contained flats. Three of the ground floor units are wheelchair-accessible. The centre provides 24hr cover and accommodation from one day, and in some instances up to twelve months, for individuals who are willing to engage in support. The progress of each resident will be carefully monitored. For those individuals who engage and progress well to get to a point where they can manage their own tenancy, they will be assisted to access move-on accommodation when they are ready to leave the project.
Opportunity title and description	Opportunity to become part of a small cross-departmental project team which will work with the residents at Oak Tree House to support them in developing skills for life and work. The project runs for half a day per week for 5 consecutive weeks at the centre and sessions include: - money management - health and wellbeing - cookery - CV writing / Interview skills - Digital skills
